RULES & REGULATIONS

1. No entry fee will be charged in exhibits or entries except Tractor and Truck Pulls, Horse Shows, Demo Derby, Tug-O-War, ATV & truck dirt races and pageants.
2. Exhibitor may participate without regard to race, color, sex, national origin or handicap.
3. The Fair Board will use the utmost care to prevent losses, accidents or injury to persons, livestock, and products. BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE SHOULD ANY OF THESE OCCUR.
4. All exhibits must be recorded with the Department Chairman in which they are shown and each exhibit must be correctly labeled with entry tags which will be furnished by management.
5. The Fair Board will interpret all rules of the fair. The decision of this board is final in the event of misunderstanding.
6. Any violation of rules will cause forfeiture of awards or denial of participation.
7. The Fair Board will not be responsible for any articles which are not picked up on Saturday, June 27th, 2026 10:00 to 12:00 pm. ITEMS NOT PICKED UP WILL BE DISPOSED OF AT 12 NOON.
8. Premiums for all exhibits except livestock will be issued Saturday, June 27th, 2026, 10:00 am – 12:00 pm at the Bourbon County Fair Office, Bourbon County Park.
9. ALL PREMIUM CHECKS WILL BE VOID 30 DAYS AFTER DATE OF ISSUE. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
10. Only judges, Department Chairmen and helpers will be allowed in exhibition hall or show ring while judging is taking place.
11. Open Class Exhibits are open to all exhibitors unless otherwise specified and must be ownership and workmanship of each exhibitor and will be judged on the American System.
12. Exhibitors must present claim tickets in order to pick up entries.
13. An exhibitor may enter only one entry in the same class with the exception of livestock.
14. Cash premiums will be awards at the livestock shows.
15. Exhibitors must be residents of Bourbon County or members of Bourbon County Homemakers, Bourbon County FFA or Bourbon County 4-H.
16. All agricultural exhibits must originate from farm or homestead within Bourbon County.
17. Admission Policy: EVERYONE who enters Bourbon County Fairgrounds is required to pay admission fee or produce official pass provided by Fair Board.

BOURBON COUNTY FAIR DEDICATION

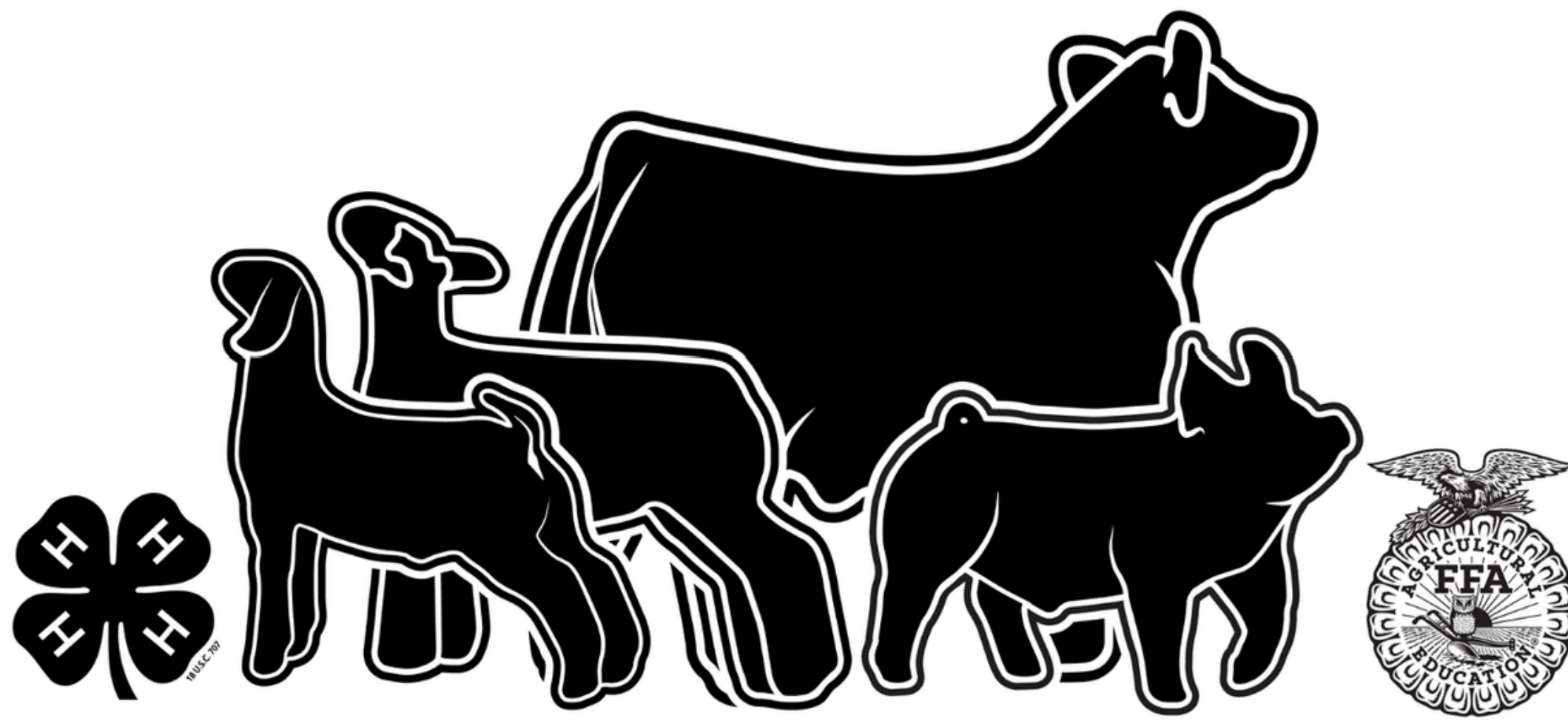
The 2026 Bourbon County Fair & Horse Show is dedicated to two very special women —

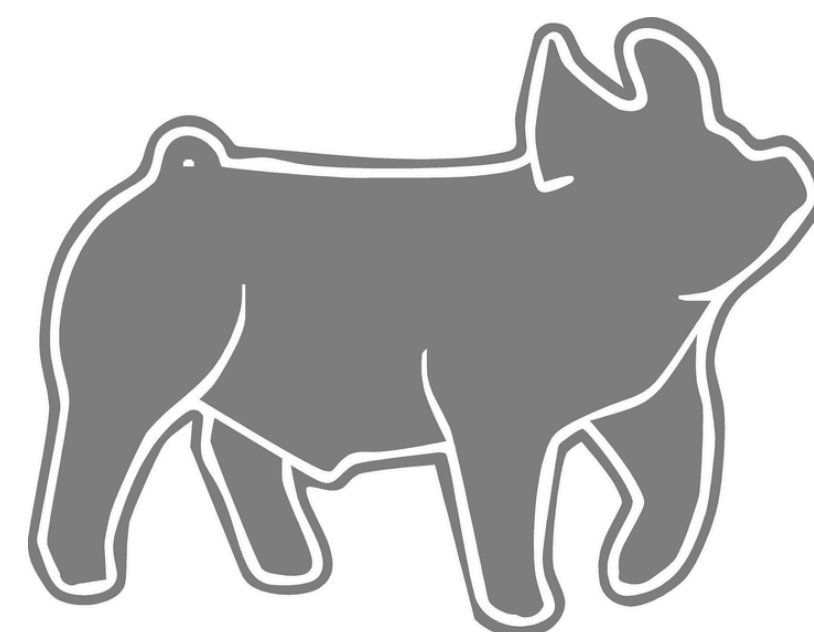

- SHOWMANSHIP ENTRIES MUST SHOW IN ONE OTHER CLASS. OPEN TO ALL YOUTH.
- ALL 4-H, FFA, AND NOVICE MARKET LAMB ENTRIES MUST BE NOMINATED IN THE EXHIBITOR'S NAME AND IDENTIFIED BY THE – KENTUCKY UNIFORM IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM. SEE 4-H AGENT OR FFA ADVISOR FOR DETAILS.
- ALL LAMBS MUST BE SHOWN BY THE EXHIBITOR (OWNER) UNLESS THE EXHIBITOR IS INCAPACITATED (DEPRIVED OF STRENGTH OR ABILITY; PHYSICALLY IMPAIRED) OR HAD MORE THAN ONE ENTRY IN A CLASS, THEN HE OR SHE MAY HAVE ANOTHER 4-H OR FFA YOUTH EXHIBIT HIS OR HER ANIMAL.
- MARKET LAMB EXHIBITORS WILL BE LIMITED TO SIX LAMBS. NOVICE EXHIBITORS WILL BE LIMITED TO TWO LAMBS.
- KUIP LAMBS CAN BE SHOWN IN EITHER BREEDING OR MARKET LAMB CLASSES OR BOTH.
- EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO REMOVE ANY LIVESTOCK BEDDING THAT IS BROUGHT INTO THE FAIRGROUNDS.
- ANYONE ENTERING GROUNDS WILL PAY ADMISSION.

**-PURE STOCK CLASS-
-NO WELD-**

******Absolutely no welding whatsoever, even on pre-run cars.******

- **All participants must be 18 years or older with proper Id.**
- May run a header.
- May run stock fuel tank in stock location as long as it is in front of the rear wheels.
- May run a fuel cell located in the middle of the rear floorboard and must be secured and covered with no movement at all.
- Any leaks with cause you to be disqualified if deemed unsafe.
- Any front wheel drive 110" or less or rear wheel drive car must have a 107" or less wheel base.
- NO all-wheel or 4-wheel drive cars.
- May wire in six spots, two strands per opening or chain all doors, trunk lid and hood.
- May run a wire or chain in windshield area for safety.
- All cars must be stripped and free of all glass before entering fairgrounds.
- May run any tire of choice with the exception of studded snow tires.
- You may run a dash bar in the dash area and behind the seat as long as it is bolted in, no welding whatsoever allowed.
- No welding rule will be enforced in this class to give everyone an equal opportunity to compete fairly.
- Helmets & eye protection must be worn at ALL TIMES while cars are on the track.
- Must move battery to safe location in passenger compartment with no movement at all and covered.

Again, this is a bone stock class. Everything must be stock to that car.

RULES FOR YOUTH

1. Exhibitors in 4-H classes must be between the ages 9 years old and 19 years old as of January 1, 2026. Exhibitors under 9 years of age may exhibit in open youth categories. Exhibitors entering the FFA must be active FFA members.
2. Youth exhibitors may not exhibit in the open class and youth class with the same project unless indicated under the rules in the specific departments. They may enter an open class and exhibit something that was not included in the youth class.
3. All exhibits must have been grown or made since July 1, 2025, and owned as of May 1, 2025. The workmanship is expected to be that of the exhibitor.
4. Exhibits are subject to the approval of the youth advisors of 4-H and FFA or personnel designated by these advisors.
5. Awards and ribbons will be judged on the Danish System unless indicated otherwise in the specific department.
6. General rules of the fair apply to youth divisions unless otherwise indicated.
7. Exhibitors must reside in Bourbon County or be a current member of Bourbon County 4-H, FFA, or FCCLA.

ADULT FAMILY AND CONSUMER EXHIBITS

The Extension Homemaker Council sponsors cash prizes for the number of Homemaker entries to the Bourbon County Fair. All dues-paying Homemakers are eligible. The Bourbon County Extension Homemaker with the most Adult Family & Consumer entries will receive \$75, second place will receive \$50, and third place will receive \$25.

The rules are:

1. You must be a paid "current" Homemaker.
2. Only 5 art exhibits will be counted.
3. You must abide by the fair categories.
4. No categories will be made to fit your entry.
5. You must advise the department workers that you are a Homemaker at the time of making entry. NAME, HOMEMAKER CLUB (OR MAILBOX MEMBER) MUST BE WRITTEN ON THE BACK OF THE ENTRY TAG.
